



The size and location in the mine will be determined based on your requirements. Exhibitors may be responsible for additional infrastructure or services. Exhibitors will work with our Mine Site Logistics and Operations Lead to determine additional requirements and assist with setup.



## SURFACE OUTDOOR DEMO

Surface placements are reserved for companies that do not require an underground environment to demonstrate technology. The size of the demonstration area will be determined based on your requirements.

## SURFACE **BUILDING FACILITIES DEMO** \$2,000 CAD\*

Indoor surface building placements are reserved for mining technology companies that do not require an underground environment to demonstrate, for example, software. The size of the demonstration area will be determined based on your requirements.

\* Please note, depending on the specifics, exhibitors may incur any additional costs associated with setting up and installing their technology in the designated demonstration zone.





The NORCAT Underground Centre has become the global destination to see the emerging technologies that are poised to transform the mining industry.


